I would encourage you to look at the original text and see if there is anything you can include in the first minute that will help bring audiences up to speed faster.*

*Delivery - Wow! You have such a strong command of this space. The way you can take a text from so long ago and make it feel modern and immediate is truly impressive. Thank you so much for committing to this text and bringing it to life.*

*Context - This is where you excelled. I loved how your introduction conveyed the importance of the speech when it was given and drew parallels to lessons we can take from it today. Very smart use of the introduction. It strengthened your whole performance for me. Kudos!*

*General Feedback - The biggest concern I have is the opening of the speech. You need to get audiences on the same page as you as early as possible in the performance. Otherwise you risk losing them for the rest of the speech! Find an adjustment, however big or small, to make to your teaser to hook people sooner. Once you have people interested, this speech is so moving and thought-provoking. Just make it easier for the audience to get there.*
